The Yokohama Specie Bank and the Bank of Taiwan are temporarily appointed as the exchange banks. The Governor may appoint Chinese Comod Banks to do such transactions when it is deemed necessary.

Fee for exchange has been increased from 0.125 per cent to 0.25 per cent.

CENTRAL RESERVE NOTES FOR CANTON. Source - 5

On 24 MAR 43 at about 1900 hrs., over ten military trucks were loaded with 'Wang's Central Government Banknotes' to be shipped to Canton by the ' 飛 丸' (pronounced in Cantonese 'KWONG TOU' KWU). These trucks were escorted by Japanese troops. There were over 400 cases, and each case was approximately 3 x 4 x 6 feet.

MINERALS & METALS - HONGKONG.

11 group have just submitted data re Japanese tests and purchases of certain minerals and metals. This information is given Appendix 'A' to this sub-division. The source is an 11 group operator who is employed in the official laboratory of the Governor's Department.

CONTROL OF PIERS - HONGKONG. (Source - 25).

On 26 Mar 43 at 1430 hrs., a meeting was held among the staff of the 海 務 局 (Harbour Department) to discuss the control of piers. The meeting was adjourned at 1530 hrs. A member of the staff of the 海 務 局 named 赤元美施 said that as from 1 Apr 43, the control of all the piers of: Canton route, Macau route, Hong loon Route, Kuanghchauwan Route, etc. will be taken over by the 海 務 局. 'Water Police Constables' (水上警衛) will not be used. The 'Water Gendarmerie' (水上憲兵) will be transferred to some other places.

This turned out to be a fact on 1 Apr 43.
