CLOTH MARKET.

(4) The cloth market in HONG KONG used to be very stable. There was a sudden rise in March and April when summer cotton cloth was sold at M¥1;500 to M¥1;600 per bolt. An inferior quality was sold at M¥1,200 to M¥1,500. Recently, owing to the diminishing number of repatriates, the demand for cloth decreased. The prices fell to M¥800 and M¥500 for superior and secondary quality cotton cloth respectively. Woolly cotton cloth is sold at about M¥600 per bolt.
