It is rumoured that the Japanese purchased several thousand bags, thus causing the present price of CRB\$10 per tael. Lower grade rice is sold at CRB\$10 for 2.2/5 taels.

LOCAL CONDITIONS.

The prices of commodities are rising, but the authorities remain silent on the present state of affairs. Life for the citizen is becoming harder. Cases of robbery are reported to be on the increase.

From 18th September, the Gendarmes, Peace Preservation Police and Special Service Corps conducted searches several times a day along the road, also in public recreation places and ten-houses. On 23rd September, the authorities issued a notification banning hoarding and profitsering, but prices failed to drop.

CANTON ARMY COMMISSARIAT.

Daily supplies such as food, clothing, etc. for the Japanese Army in SOUTH CHINA apart from a small portion from FORMOSA and NOATH CHINA, are mostly manufactured and prepared in CANTON. This is what they call "To maintain a war by war". The necessary raw materials are collected and acquired locally, and in the neighbouring areas.

The CANTON COMMISSARIAT is located at TUNG KAU CHEUNG (東友 場) the Eastern Parade Ground (286471). The Japs have erected factories with galvanized iron, and used the originally existing buildings as godowns. The entire compound occupies approximately 145,000 square metres of which one-fifth is covered with buildings.

The establishment is under the control of MAmI (沒) 8600 Butai, who are under the supervision of the South China Expeditionary Force Command.

The products are not only for supplying NAMI (次)
Butmis, but also all other units in CANTON and other parts of
South China.
