TAXATION.

Today the Governor's Office publishes Order No. 59 revising the amusement tax. The essential points are (1) hitherto the tax was reckoned according to the type of amusement, while now all amusements are taxed uniformly; (2) formerly charges up to 20 sen were tax free, while now the amount is altered to MY1.

TRAVEL REGULATIONS.

In April this year, the HONGKONG Harbour Office issued Notice No. 2 stipulating that all travellers to and from HONGKONG were restricted to carrying only a medium-sized bag, and required to fill in an application form listing all articles in their luggage, to be presented to the Harbour Office inspectors on their departure and arrival. The Harbour Office announced yesterday that the said notice is to be cancelled as from today. It is no longer necessary for travellers to list the articles in their luggage. However, the luggage allowed each passenger is still restricted to a medium-sized bag.
